BY CAR:

FROM BOE OR GOWANUS EXPRESSWAY (I278)

Take exit #24 for the Prospect Expressway East (State Hwy. Route #27 East). Take exit #4 for 10th and 11th Avenues. Immediately make a right turn upon exiting onto 10th Avenue / John P. Devaney Blvd. Turn right at 20th Street. Turn right at Prospect Park West (9th Avenue). Turn right at 19th Street. Gym entrance will be on your right. Please enter through the gym doors.

FROM OCEAN PKWY

Take Ocean Parkway and continue straight to Prospect Expressway West (State Hwy. Route # 27 West). Take exit #3 for 8th and 7th Avenues. Turn right upon exiting onto 8th Avenue. Turn right at 17th Street. Turn right Prospect Park West (9th Avenue). Turn left at 19th Street. Gym entrance will be on your right, please enter through gym doors.

BY TRAIN:

F – Train to 15th Street / Prospect Park Station, exit from the Windsor Place staircase. Walk to and turn southwest onto Prospect Park West. Walk southwest on Prospect Park West and turn left at 19th street. Gym entrance will be on your right, please enter through gym doors.
